Built in Australia since 1939

The facility produces cookers and ovens under the Electrolux, Westinghouse and Chef brands.








Better Living Program

Electrolux has been committed to shaping living for the better for over 100 years. In 2019 they launched their most important initiative yet, The Better Living Program. The program is an 11 yr action plan by Electrolux that aims to shape better and more sustainable living around the world. Its focus is an evolving list of 100 bold actions that they pledge to undertake by 2030. These actions represent their commitment to the four clear targets they have defined across the categories of Better Eating, Better Garment Care, Better Home Environment and Better Company.



EBV also share a rich local history with Electrolux, with Brunswick previously being home to 1 of 13 Electrolux manufacturing plants outside of home country Sweden.

Electrolux's connection to Brunswick began in 1906, when The Lux Foundry purchased a site in Hope St, Brunswick. The company's popular Lux brand stoves and ranges were produced on this site until the late 1950s, when the firm was taken over by the Ferrier Company who manufactured the iconic Chef oven until production was moved interstate in 2001 where it continues today in Dudley Park, Adelaide. The iconic Lux Foundry building still stands today as a café and event space.
